S + V (s)

I **eat** pizza every Fryday.

She **eats** pizza every Friday.

Present Continuos

S + AM/IS/ARE + V - ING

I **am eating** pizza now.

She **is eating** pizza now.

Present simple	Present continuous
I (listen) to music every day.	I (listen) to music now .
You (watch) TV at now.	You (watch) TV right now .
He never (use) the cellphone in class.	He (use) the cellphone in class in this moment .
She sometimes (play) volleyball.	She (play) volleyball at the moment .
It usually (rain) in summer.	It (rain) now .
We always (wear) the school uniform.	We (wear) the school uniform right now .
You (visit) the museum once a month.	You (visit) the museum once at the moment .
They (read) a new book every week.	They (read) a new book in this moment .
Emma always (do) the homework at 3 o'clock.	Emma (do) the homework now .
Edward usually (have) lunch at school.	Edward (have) lunch at school right now .
My friend sometimes (ride) a bike in the park.	My friend (ride) a bike in the park at the moment .
My friends often (have dinner) at McDonalds.	My friends (have dinner) at McDonalds in this moment .
John and Brenda hardly ever (do) gym.	John and Brenda (do) gym now .
My mum never (cook) pizza.	My mum (cook) pizza right now .
My dad (wash) his car every Sunday.	My dad (wash) his car at the moment .
