Spelling rules	Examples
base form + ed	walk → walked play → played
verbs ending in -e +d	like → liked move → moved
verbs ending in a consonant + y \downarrow change y \rightarrow i + ed	carry → carried study → studied
Some verbs ending in a single consonant + the second last letter is a vowel → double the last letter + ed	plan → planned stop → stopped
