THE "S" RULE

Third Person Singular

He – She – It



In English, when we talk about he, she or it (third person singular) in the Present Simple, most verbs take "s" at the end.



EXAMPLES

He

(ele)



eats

(come)

He eats fruit.



She

(ela)



drinks

(bebe)

She drinks water.



It

(isso/ele/ela – para animais ou coisas)



goes

(vai)

It goes to the park.



REMEMBER!



We add -s to the verb when the subject is:

- **He** (ele)
- **She** (ela)
- **It** (isso/ele/ela – para animais ou coisas)

SPELLING RULES (WITH -S)

Most verbs: add -s play – plays

Verbs ending in -s, -ch, -sh: add -es

watch – watches / fixes / go – goes / wash – wash

Verbs ending in consonant + y: change y to i and add -es

study – studies / try – tries
